Completion Capital Campaign

Can you believe it? Out of a \$2.6 million dollar project, we only owe about \$236,000. To help us pay off this loan as quickly as possible, the deacons have proposed a two-year Completion Capital Campaign to begin in June, 2013 and end in May, 2015. I hope everyone will consider giving over and beyond their budget gifts to help us accomplish our goal. Some people can give more than this, but if all of our current giving units would give approximately \$600-1000/year, we will have no problem paying it off. That's \$12-15/week, or \$50-80/month.

To participate, simply get a pledge card and envelope (available at the church), and turn it in to the office or bring it to worship on June 2. Those who sow sparingly reap sparingly, but those who sow generously will also reap generously! Thanks for your generous spirit!
